Thanks for the contact details, in terms of your additional queries, please see below.

**Who will be there:** The invited audience will be local faith groups, community groups and voluntary sector organisations – c. 50 invited organisations (once finalised) including local groups focused on protecting Lea Valley Park – we will likely afford 2 places per invited organisation.

**What's the structure and how will it be run:** 3 hour session facilitated by Sandra Fryer (experienced planning consultant) and myself. Short context intro, short presentation of the key elements of the Vision, structured themed round table discussions seeking feedback on aspects of the Vision and encouraging people to visit the online consultation portal to submit formal responses to the consultation exercise. Next steps outlining future on-going engagement with local people, groups and organisations. Opportunity for Q&A then more detailed discussion around the pop-up exhibition banners/round table themed discussions.

**Who is chairing:** We're hoping it won't need formal chairing, more facilitation of discussion, but again this will be handled by either Sandra or myself, depending on who delivers the presentation..

**Why would you like us at this particular meeting:** We're anticipating interest from local groups about the proposed LVRP aspirational developments shown in the Vision, including at the Ice centre, waterworks centre and associated sites. LVRPs aspirations for development will impact on existing Metropolitan Open Land (MOL) designated land, so it would be helpful to have someone present to help field specific questions.

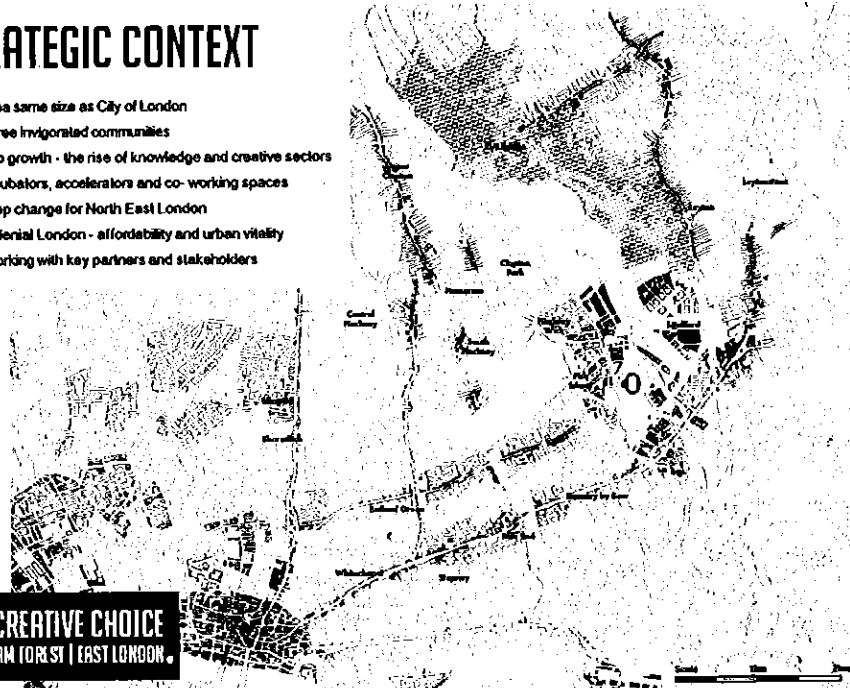

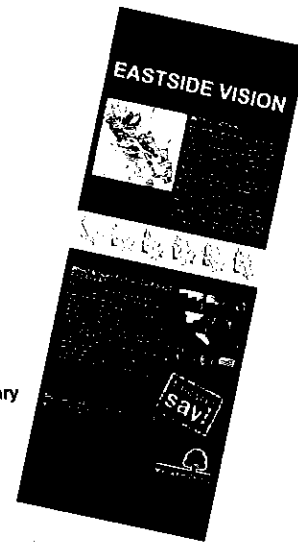

Thanks for your prompt response to my earlier email.

The Trust is keen to get moving on the project for the riding centre but has to go through one internal 'approval' meeting before we submit. I appreciate your advice re meeting to discuss a masterplan for the area and hope that we can build on Allies's work in developing a masterplan once your vision document is approved by cabinet. This should embrace the Waterworks centre and the large areas of open spaces and address issues of improved public access and the land at Connaught Close. My personal view is that we should retain AM as our consultants for this more detailed work building on their knowledge and expertise of both the area and working with you. It is probably best left until after Xmas to meet to discuss this. I will send over some dates next week when [REDACTED] (copied) and I can meet.

I think we can distinguish between the car wash canopies in that the roofing over the outdoor menage is broadly consistent with the purpose of the MOL, a small development on an existing centre complimentary to MOL. Your DM policies at DM 12 and CS5 can be interpreted as providing support for this project.

We are consulting on a vision and not a masterplan.

We will aim to take this to Cabinet in February for adoption. It will feed into the council's direction of travel for reviewing the local plan, although this is still to be agreed by members.

I imagine your programme for the submission of a planning application will run ahead of the timetable for reviewing the local plan. As discussed previously you will therefore need to provide a justification for inappropriate development in the MOL.

In my opinion, this would be best done as part of a comprehensive framework of improvement of sports facilities and improvements to the ecology, landscape and accessibility of the Park.

I note that there are proposals for a cover to the manege at the riding school. This would also be inappropriate development and in my view should also be considered as part of an overall strategy for the Park.

I think the best way of taking this forward would be for you to come in and meet Rob and I to discuss a brief for consultants to take this forward for you.
